



UNIFORM POLICY

Rationale

A uniform dress code reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school.

Purpose

- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.
- To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community.

Implementation:

- Wearing of School uniforms is compulsory.
- Uniforms may be purchased online from State School Relief using the free Qkr App. Delivery will be made to the school. Postage costs for returns will be incurred by parents/carers and will need to be accompanied by a SSR purchase returns form. If the item is faulty or incorrect from original order, please return to the school office within 14 days.
- Iron on logos, costing \$2.00 each, are available from the Glenallen Club (contact the school office 9561 1966)
- The Dress Code applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.
- School hats, consistent with our Sunsmart policy must be worn outside in Terms 1 & 4. Hats are not to be worn inside.
- The student Dress Code, including details of uniform items and places of purchase, will be published in the newsletter at the start of each year.
- The Principal be responsible for implementation of the Dress Code in a manner consistent with the Student Code of Conduct.
- Arrangements can be made to supply uniforms via State Schools Relief for families experiencing economic hardship.
- Parents seeking exemptions to the Dress Code must apply in writing to the School Council for consideration.

Uniform details:

Uniform for Primary School students:

Girls

- Green and white check dress
- Green windcheater
- Green bomber jacket with or without the red bands
- Green pants/shorts
- Green polo shirts
- Green polar fleece jacket/vest

Boys

- Green windcheater
- Green bomber jacket with or without the red bands
- Green pants/shorts
- Green polo shirts
- Green polar fleece jacket/vest

Uniform for Senior School students:

As for Primary School but with the following changes:

- Red and white check dress
- Red polo shirt
- Red polar fleece jacket/vest

Uniform for Transition School students:

As for Senior School but with the following changes:

- Black polo shirts with or without white bands
- Black pants/shorts
- Black polar fleece jacket/vest
